## WAYS TO CELEBRATE!

- Do a listening zoo where kids bring their stuffed animals and read to them. Then have 2 or 3 students share with the whole class. (Good idea for writing celebration in September.)
- Partners join with other partnerships and share their pieces.
- Toast to living the `writerly life' with a glass of Sprite.
- Class sits together and each student reads out a favorite line, ending, etc.
- Students pick a line from their partners' pieces and read them aloud (choral read around room).
- Museum walk with compliments
  (write compliments on Post-Its).
- Put the published pieces in a basket in your classroom library with compliments from the students on Post-Its attached to them.
- Students send pieces out into world to someone they wrote

- about or who might be interested in the piece.
- Pair up with a school or class, put pieces online, and blog about the pieces.
- Write an author blurb for your partner.
- Illustrate another author's piece (maybe make a cover).
