Suicide Prevention Specialist	Dr. Brown and Director of Student Support Services, Kip Farnum, provided background information regarding the suicide prevention specialist. The board previously directed Mr. Farnum to contact other local agencies to see if they would be interested in partnering with the district to provide a full-time suicide specialist for the community. At this time, there is no interest from other agencies to enter this partnership. The board agreed that the district's 504 coordinator will provide half time 504 coordinator services and half time suicide prevention services for the district.
Thunder Basin High School Walking Path Easement	Mr. Eisenhower provided information regarding a walking path for students to access Thunder Basin High School. The board asked Mr. Eisenhower to initiate conversations with the land owner with respect to obtaining an easement and to bring a cost proposal for this project, including sidewalk and fencing, to the board at a later date.
